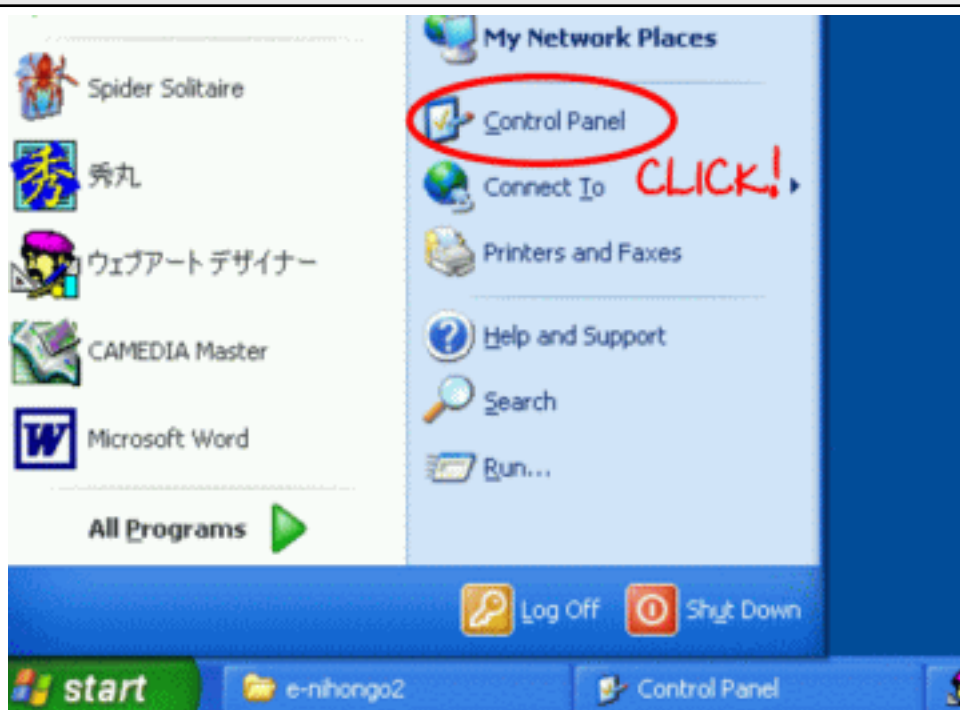
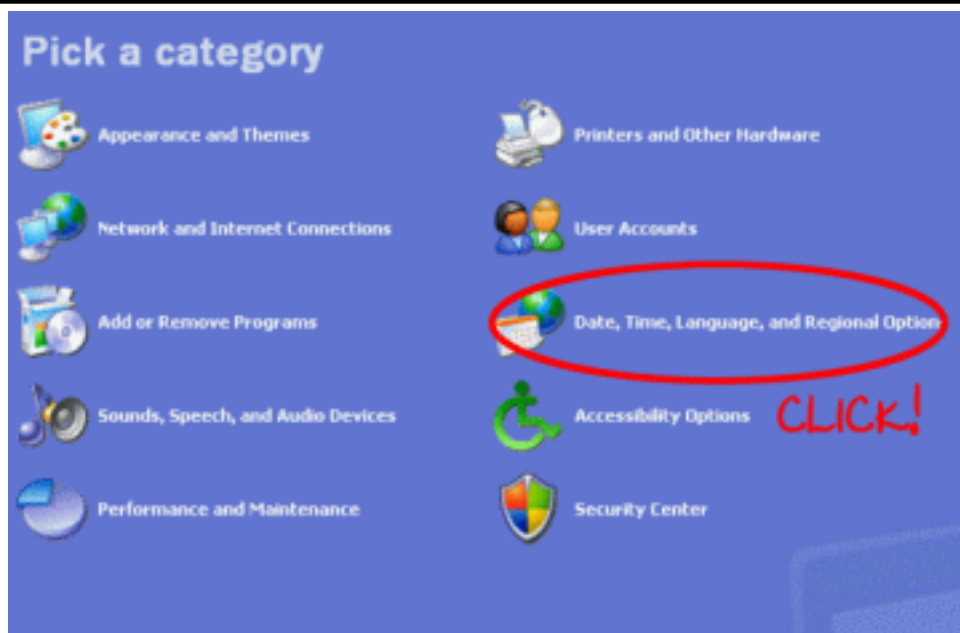


# How to display Language Bar by Kumiko SUE

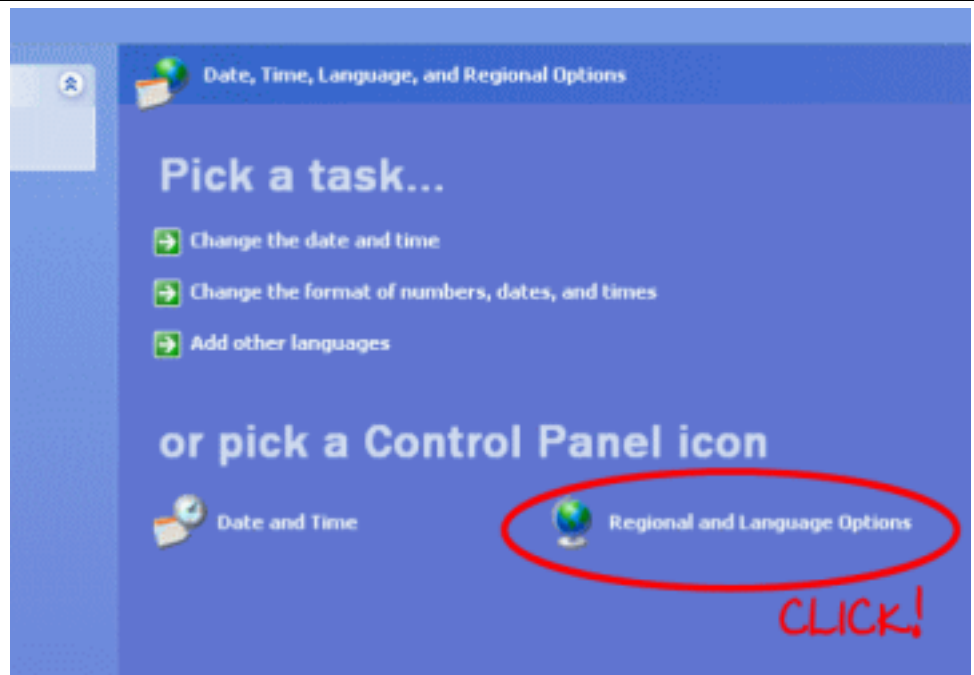
1. Click **Start** at the bottom left, and click **Control Panel**.



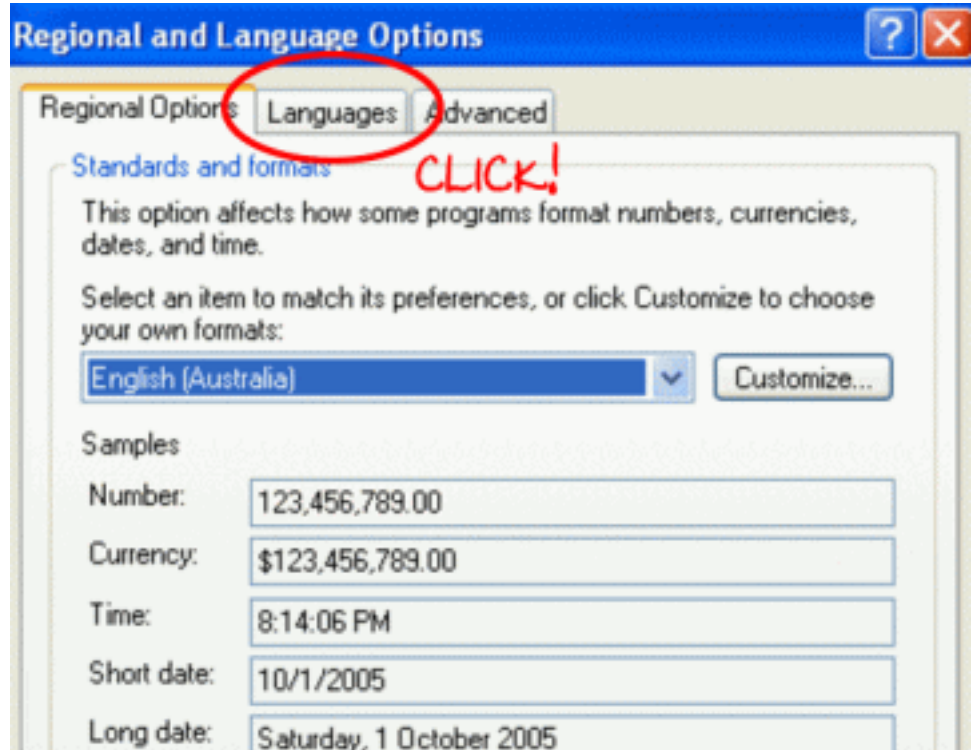
2. Click **Date, Time, Language, and Regional Option**.



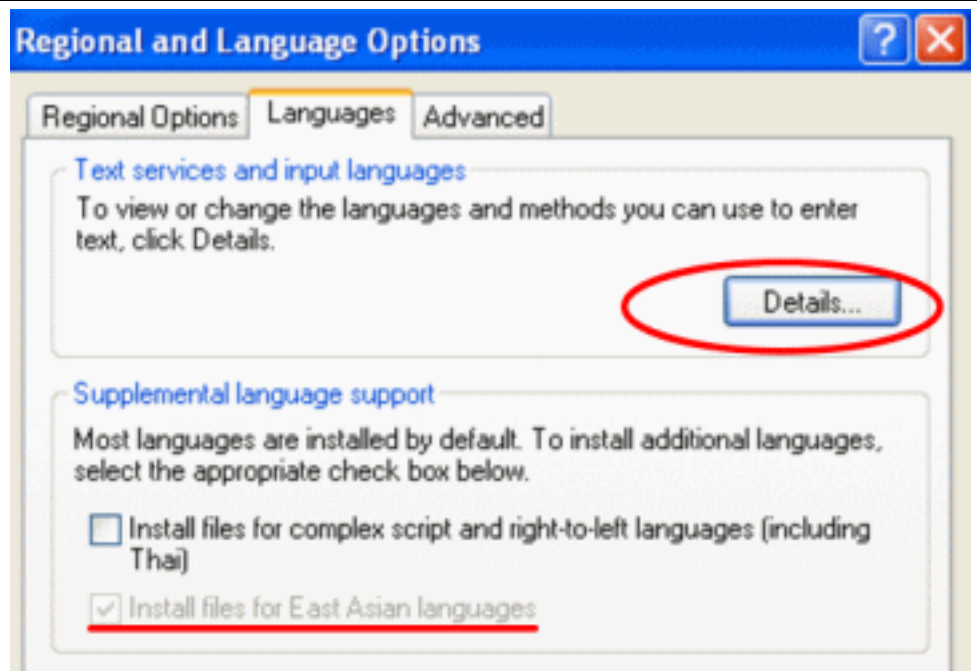
3. Click **Regional and Language Options**.



4. Click **Languages**.



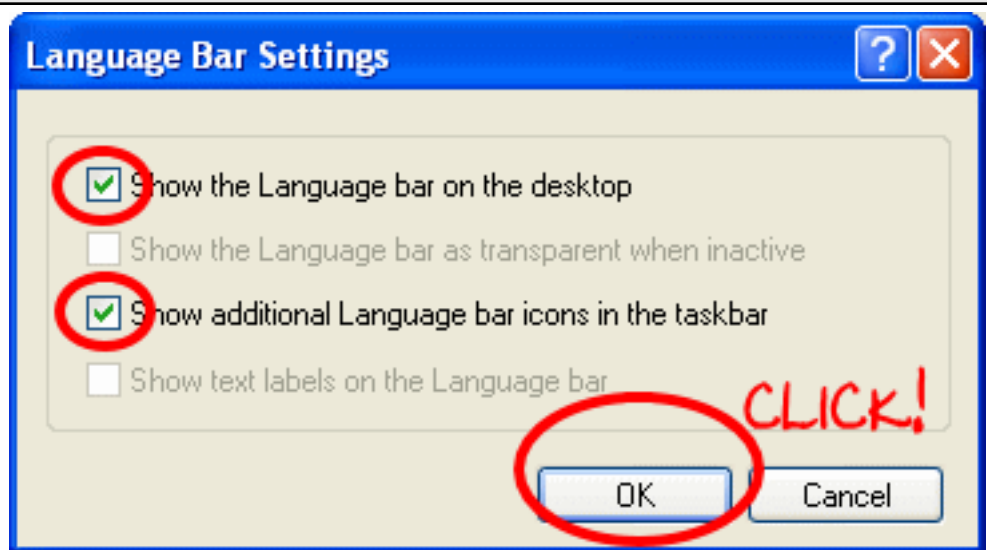
5. Click **Details...**



6. Click **Language Bar.**



7. Check both **"Show the Language bar on the desktop"** and **"Show additional Language bar icons in the task bar"**. Finally, click OK.



8. Your **Language bar** is back!

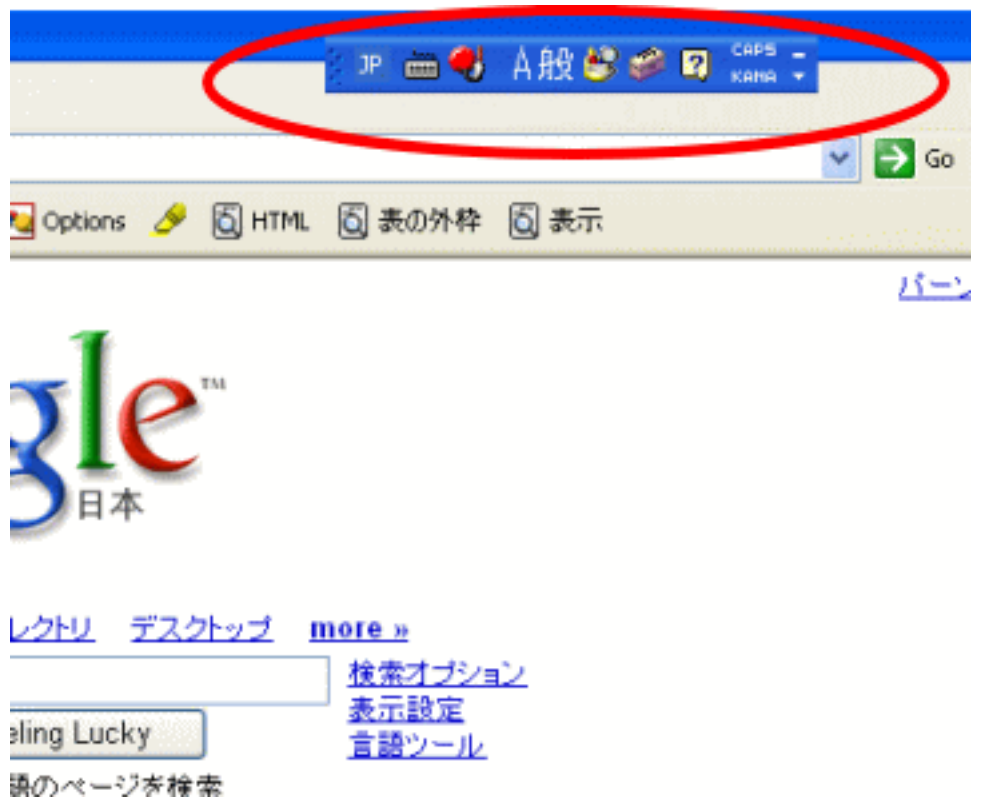


9. **This procedure is just an additional idea for your convenience.**
